May letter

One of the purposes of the church is praying for people in all kinds of distress. This we do in our daily prayers and every Sunday Although often people don't feel the need to go to church, many value prayer and it is our job to provide the means for people to pray. I am always incredibly moved by the prayers that are hung on the prayer tree in the church porch. They come from the heart. Every so often I put those prayers in a book which is placed on the altar each Sunday and I offer them up to God.

One member of the congregation wrote this lovely poem about the Prayer Tree in the porch.

THE ERPINGHAM PRAYER TREE
In the draughty corner of the porch
I wait for you.
Why not pause and take a label, maybe two?
Go in, sit still, until........
In the soft silence of these sacred stones
The feelings flow,
Your words are woven

Warm my cold fingers
With your living prayers;
Trust me to point them daily
To their Destination.

Turn away homeward now
With lighter tread,
As brightened with new leaves of love I bow my head.

We have also placed some prayer cards in church for anyone who like one to take and to use at home or to sit in the quiet of the building to pray and reflect. I hope to also have some pebbles in another position in church for people to meditate with. (If you have any polished stones or attractive pebbles and would like to donate them - please let me know) We will pray for you if you have any requests, they can simply be emailed to me.

Another aspect of our prayer life is that on the first Sunday of each month at the end of the Erpingham service we will be offering prayers for healing. All are welcome to come to these services.

There are many prayer Apps to be found on line if you would like help with your prayers. One I particularly like is called Lectio 365, it is free and there are prayers for the morning and evening, I find the evening ones particularly helpful as I wind down from the day. Prayer is an adventure, it doesn't have to be stiff, I often pray as I am driving. Music, the wonderful created world, poetry a special interest can all lead us to prayerfulness. It doesn't have to be stiff and starchy. Remember that Jesus called God 'dad'






